Introducing Young People to the Symphony Orchestra

EMFkids' participants receive a top-notch introduction to classical music and the orchestra through hands-on learning. Experienced instructors from The Music Academy of North Carolina provide a kid-friendly and creative approach to music through instrument demonstrations, rehearsal visits, an instrument petting zoo, making and playing instruments, singing, and a unique introduction to melody, harmony, and rhythm. In addition to the morning activities, each participant is given two tickets to an EMF orchestral performance during the week of the camp!

Visits to the Orchestra

A once-in-a-lifetime experience! EMFkids campers take daily trips to the orchestra, where a professional conductor gives a short introduction to each instrument family—strings, woodwinds, brass, and percussion. EMFkids campers will be up-close and personal with some of the nation's top student orchestral musicians.

Backstage Pass: The Making of Music

EMF*Explorers* is back with an enhanced curriculum! With backstage access to professional musicians and exclusive performances, participants will gain hands-on experience in the recording industry and explore a variety of current music genres, including gypsy jazz, musical theater, and classical music. In collaboration with EMF, the Music Academy of North Carolina will provide an innovative curriculum, experienced instructors, and special discount offers for students desiring to take private music lessons outside of the camp.

Program Schedule

Each day starts with percussion and movement activities (inspired by the sensation “Stomp!”) using ordinary objects—pots, pans, and buckets—to make extraordinary rhythms. Participants play compositions in a variety of styles and traditions, including West African drum circles and Japanese ensemble taiko. Students learn intricate rhythms while bringing the performances to life with movement!

Day 1: Celebrate Gypsy Jazz! Join members of Swing Triade to learn the basics of this invigorating musical genre and join in with some tunes of your own.

Day 2: You are the Composer. Try your hand at storytelling and write your own musical accompaniment using drums, percussion instruments, piano/keyboard, voice, and electronic sound effects.

Day 3: Visit MARS, the Music Academy’s Recording Studio. Explore the basics of up-to-date recording technology using Mac Pro Tools to record, mix, and edit your own take-home CD.

Day 4: Take Center Stage! Explore all aspects of opera and musical theater, including singing, stage production, costuming, choreography, props and scenery, stage fighting, and stage presence.

Day 5: A Day of Classical Music—with a real orchestra and conductor! Experience a dress rehearsal of a pre-professional classical orchestra and a Q & A session with a conductor.
